# URUGUAY | Why to choose this country

One of the fastest routes to passport (in 5,5 years after first arrival if all prerequisites are met)

1

2

No legal requirement to stay in Belgium all year long. Most activities which need your attention can be carried out online

3

Possibility to obtain fiscal Non-Resident status to avoid having to report worldwide income- pay no tax on worldwide income

4

Fast family reunification right after you get your residence

5

Passport ranks top-35 in the world

6

Resident Permit possible in just two visits to the country, and you don't need a company (legal entity)

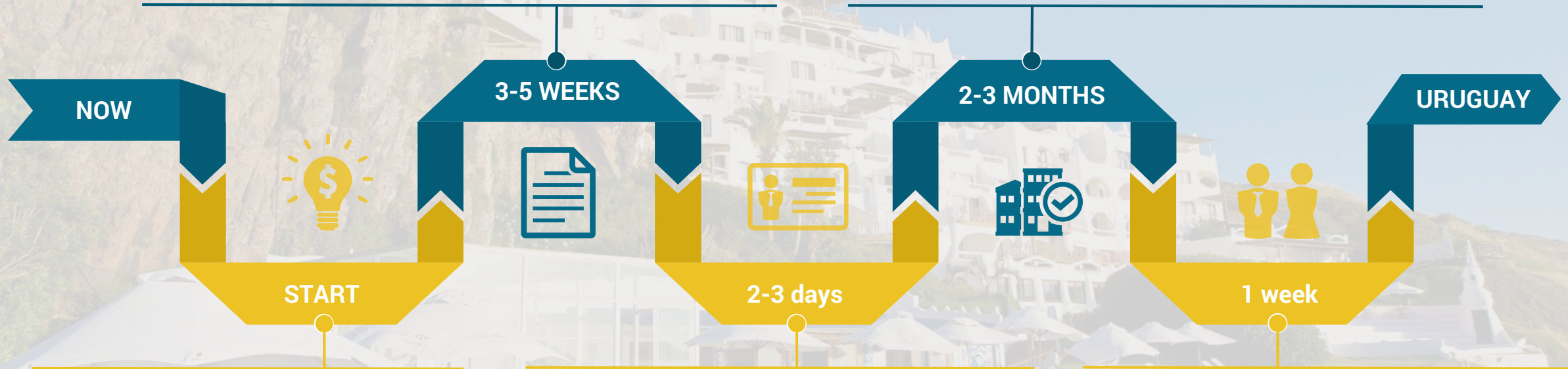


# URUGUAY and timing

## Residence application process

★ We prepare the business case and full set of documents. You prepare police clearance certificate and birth/marriage certificate, legalize them and travel to Paraguay for 3 days

★ You travel back to Paraguay and apply for residence permit, you stay for 1 week



★ The process is started once **the contract** has been **signed and we** have **received the prepayment and your CV**

★ We open the **immigration case and submit all documents in Paraguay** and you go back to wait for **2-3 months**

★ You pick up your residence card in Uruguay

# URUGUAY | Fees and costs

## First Residence permit



Prepayment necessary to start – **3995 EUR**



Government fees at your application submission – **100 EUR**



Address for registration **2000 EUR**



Residence permit fee **200 EUR**



Final payment to us – **3995 EUR** after your file is approved



**25% discount** to our fees | if first payment made within 2 weeks from today

**Total costs and fees for the first Residence permit – 10100 EUR**

## Next Residence permit

Taxes to pay per year – approx. **500 EUR**



No company costs



Government fees to renew residence permit after first 2 years – **400 EUR**. Validity of new permit – 3 years



You have to pay for mail management **1000 EUR/year**



Our renewal fees are **2500 EUR**.



**Total minimum annual fees – 1950 EUR**

# URUGUAY | How do we start

01

Send to [a@euresidence.me](mailto:a@euresidence.me):

★ scanned copy of your travel passport

★ your legal address (where you live now) and your Residence permit copy if you live outside of your home country



02

Once you have signed the contract and paid the first provision we will start processing your case. You will need to obtain: Police clearance for the last five years, bank statement (total balance only)



03

We will contact you once all the documents are ready for you submit them to the embassy in the country where you normally live. The rest of our company's fees is due when your Professional card is approved



# URUGUAY | Frequent questions

## 1. Where do I apply for a Residence permit?

– You will need to fly in to Uruguay to apply for your Residence

## 2. Can my family join me?

- Normally yes, after you have received your residence permit

## 3. Can I become a citizen of Uruguay?

-Yes, if you fulfill the conditions, in about five years.  
First, you must be in the possession of the Permanent Resident status.

## 4. As the holder of the residence permit, am I obliged to stay in the country all the time?

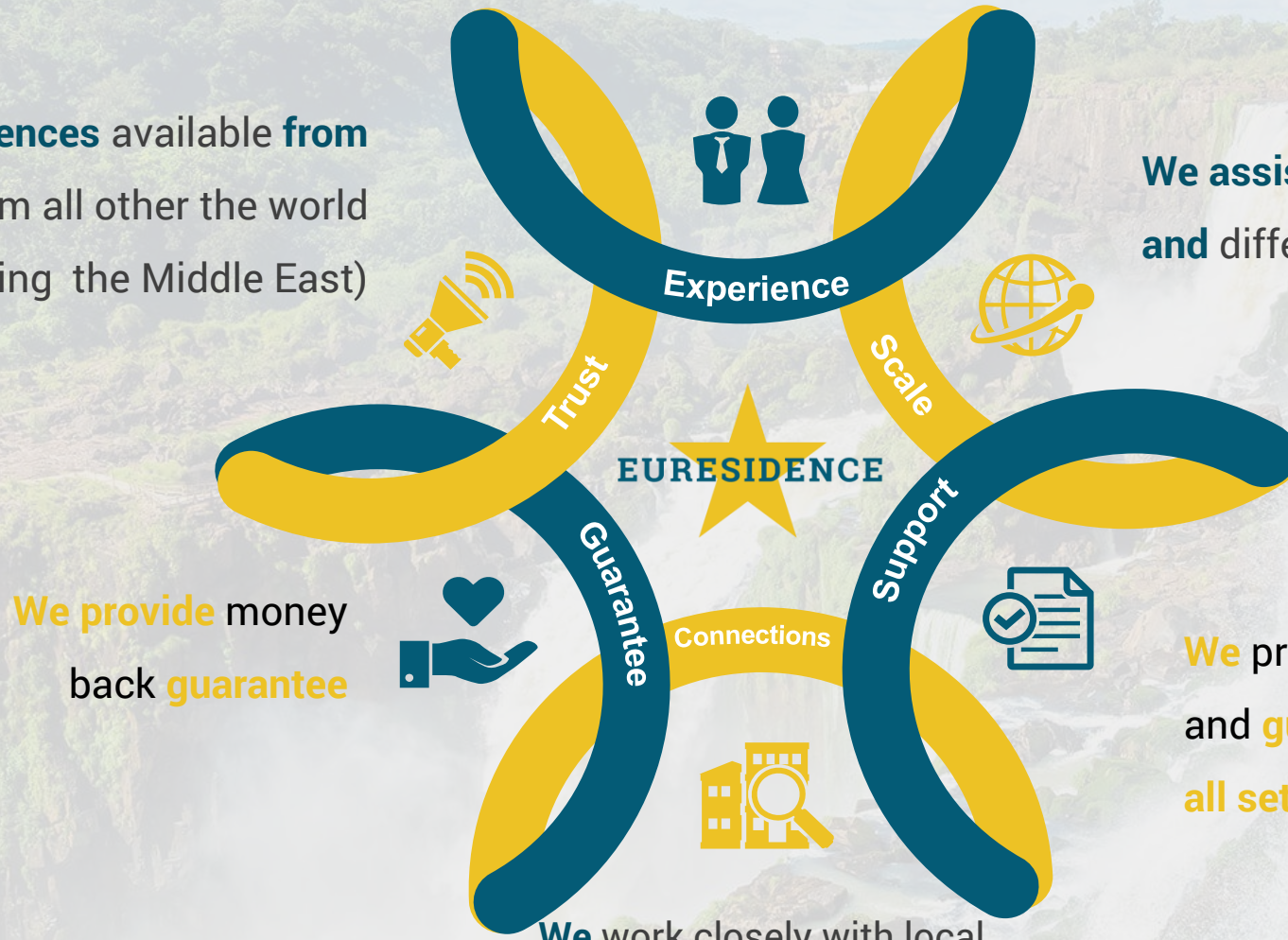
-No, you can travel. You must only make sure that you maintain your residence address and that you do receive post.
